Warren County Deputies will be on the roads beginning Saturday April 12<sup>th</sup> through Sunday May 14<sup>th</sup> to provide extra traffic enforcement while our area high school students are celebrating Prom season. The Warren County Sheriff's Office received a Select Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant from the state of Ohio for 2014. Throughout this year, the STEP grant funds will be spent on a number of "blitz" efforts to increase safety on the roadways by enforcing traffic laws.
