Warren County Sheriff's Office Investigating Vehicle Break Ins

The Warren County Sheriff's Office is investigating a sudden increase of vehicle break-ins. On 5/10/17 and 5/11/17 a total of 9 vehicles were broken into in South Lebanon, Wayne Township and Turtle Creek Township area. At least three subjects have been observed getting into unlocked cars and taking items of value. They have also entered open garage doors and taken items from vehicles inside. Detectives are asking for the public's help in identifying the subjects in the attached photos. We are also urging the public to make sure their vehicles are locked when they are parked outside and to make sure all garage doors are closed. The public is also urged not to leave any valuables inside their vehicle.
