### Deputies Seek to Identify Hit And Run Driver

July 25, 2017

Deputies from the Warren County Sheriff's Office are requesting the public's help in identifying a hit and run driver from earlier this morning. Shortly after midnight, a white male crashed his truck into seven vehicles in the parking lot of McDonalds on Kings Mills Road in Deerfield Township. Fortunately, all of the struck vehicles were unoccupied however, two of the vehicles sustained major damage.

Surveillance video from the incident showed a white male and a female passenger in the truck. The male has a tattoo on the underside of his left forearm and possibly additional tattoos on the upper arm. The truck is a black Ford F150 with a tan stripe running around the bottom of the vehicle. A white decal is also apparent on the center of the rear window. The truck should have heavy damage to the front and passenger side. Pictures are attached with this release.
