Warren County Detectives Need Help Identifying Suspects In Deerfield Township Porsche SUV Thefts And Credit Card Fraud.

On November 29, 2012 around 8:45AM, two black males wearing black pants and black shirts were observed on the lot of Kings Porsche at 9847 Kings Automall Drive. Minutes later, one of the black males was observed driving a white 2013 Porsche Cayenne SUV on Fields Ertel Road by an employee of the dealership. In addition, shortly thereafter it was discovered that a second white 2013 Porsche Cayenne was also missing from the dealership lot.

Earlier the same morning around 8:20 AM 5 black males wearing all black clothing, entered the BP Station at 9855 Mason Montgomery Rd. The suspects were involved in fraudulent transactions to occur inside the BP Station. The suspects left the station driving a full size Ford conversion van that was two-tone light green and silver in color. The van displayed Illinois temporary license tag bearing 145P279.

Surveillance video was obtained from the BP station which is believed to be the same individuals who were observed on the lot of Kings Porsche just before the vehicles were taken.
