Warren County Sheriff's Office Looking For Wanted Sex Offender

The Warren County Sheriff's Office, along with the Ohio Adult Parole Authority, are looking for Larry Tumbleson, age 41, a convicted Rapist, Kidnapper and Robber that walked away from the Turtlecreek Center on August 10, 2014. Tumbleson who was convicted in 2009 and spent five (5) years in prison was released in 2013. In July of this year, Tumbleson was sent to the Turtlecreek Center, which houses people that are still under the supervision of the Adult Parole Authority and are in between prison and full release from their prison sentence.

On August 10, 2014, Tumbleson walked away from the center. Because of Tumbleson conviction for rape, he is required to notify the sheriff's office of any change in his address.

Tumbleson is wanted for Failing to Notify a Change in Address and also for a Parole Violation. Anyone with information as to Tumbleson's whereabouts is encourage to contact the Warren County Sheriff's Office or The Ohio Adult Parole Authority.

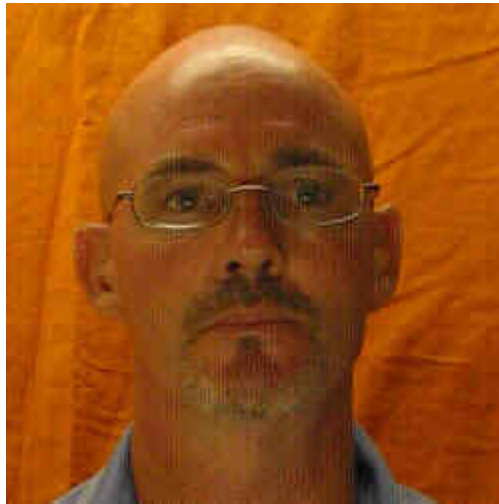
