Critical Missing Female and Child

Warren County Deputies are investigating a critical missing female and young child. Holly Marie Hockstok, 33-year-old white female, was reported missing by family members on today's date. Ms. Hockstok and her 7-year-old son left daycare today in a white 2014 Toyota Prius. (Ohio registration HCR-7166) Family members state she is experiencing mental health issues as of late and are concerned about her wellbeing. Last known location was in the Sharonville Ohio area. Citizens are urged to contact local law enforcement if they believe they have seen Ms. Hockstok.

Ms. Hockstok is described as a white female 5ft 3in tall weighing approximately 145lbs. She has brown hair and brown eyes and wears glasses. She was last seen wearing blue jeans, gray heels, with a light colored blouse with a t-shirt underneath. Her son is described as a white male 7-years-old with brown hair and brown eyes and is approximately 4ft tall.
