Intoxicated Male Arrested and Tased

On Thursday, April 11, 2013, at around 11:00 P.M., Deputies William Langdon and Kyle Turner of the Deerfield Township Post of the Warren County Sheriff's Office were dispatched to investigate a possible intoxicated driver in the 2800 block of Millbank Row, in Deerfield Township.

The deputies located the vehicle, which was unoccupied and illegally parked on Millbank Row. After receiving an additional report of a suspicious male walking in the area, they located the suspected driver, Roberto Jose Gomez, age 28, of Landen, walking behind one of the residential apartment buildings nearby.

Once Deputy Langdon made contact with Gomez, he became uncooperative and began to resist efforts to further detain him. A physical struggle ensued, and Gomez continued to resist the efforts of Deputy Langdon to place him into custody. After a couple of minutes, Gomez broke free and began to run from Deputy Langdon. Deputy Langdon pursued Gomez on foot and Tased him in order to get him to stop.

Gomez was then taken into custody. He was determined to be highly intoxicated.

Gomez is currently being held in the Warren County Jail. He is charged with Resisting Arrest, Obstructing Official Business and numerous traffic related charges.
