## <u>DEPUTIES WILL BE OUT FOR SUPER BOWL "BLITZ" TRAFFIC</u> <u>ENFORCEMENT</u>

The Warren County Sheriff's Office is joining with other law enforcement agencies around the state of Ohio by providing additional patrol units during Super Bowl weekend for the enforcement of traffic violations. This Blitz weekend runs between January 30 through February 4, and deputies will be focusing on the enforcement of speed, seat belt use, and driving while intoxicated offenses.

The Sheriff's Office received a Selected Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) grant from the State of Ohio to provide additional patrols throughout the next year. We will be focusing patrols during various holidays throughout the year in an effort to reduce traffic fatalities and injuries as a result of dangerous driving.

The Super Bowl blitz begins at noon on January 30 and ends at midnight on February 4. We urge sports fans who choose to drink while celebrating to make alternative transportation arrangements in advance in order to be prepared. Remember, fans don't let fans drive drunk!
