Those to be remembered; Officer George Basore (Franklin Police Department), Sheriff W.E. Graham (Warren County Sheriff's Office), Deputy Homer Burlile (Warren County Sheriff's Office), Chief James Elder (Mason Police Department), Officer William Johnson (Springboro Police Department), Officer Jeffrey Phegley (Morrow Police Department), and Sergeant Brian Dulle (Warren County Sheriff's Office) who all gave their lives in service to their community. In addition to those who have fallen in the line of duty, a moment of silence will be dedicated to all Warren County Law Enforcement Officers who are no longer with us today.

The public is welcome to attend the ceremony that will be held at the memorial near the Warren County Sheriff's Office, 550 Justice Drive Lebanon, Ohio. Those community members wishing to attend are asked to park in the parking lot of the Warren County Administration Building, 406 Justice Drive. After completion of the ceremony, a procession will begin at the memorial and end at Heritage Church, 2234 Utica Road, Lebanon, Ohio. Once the procession is complete, all surviving members of fallen officers, elected officials, and all active law enforcement officers are invited to remain at Heritage Church to attend the FOP Memorial Luncheon provided by the Warren County Sheriff's Office and the Warren County Prosecutor's Office.
