St. Patrick's Day Blitz Impaired Driving Enforcement Program

The Warren County Sheriff's Office, in conjunction with the Warren County Safe Communities Coalition and other local law enforcement agencies, is participating in a six-day traffic enforcement blitz that will focus on arresting intoxicated drivers. The purpose of this blitz is to aggressively enforce alcohol-related traffic offenses to reduce fatalities and injury accidents around the St. Patrick's Day holiday.

As part of the grant period 2014-2015, the Sheriff's Office will use grant funding towards targeted patrols in our effort to reduce traffic-related injuries and fatalities that are a result of intoxicated driving. Between the dates of March 13-18, the Sheriff's Office will have additional units on patrol for targeted traffic enforcement for the purpose of locating intoxicated drivers.

We urge our community members to plan ahead and make arrangements for a designated driver to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable St. Patrick's Day weekend. The life you save by doing so just might be your own!
