Major Barry Riley graduates from the FBI National Academy

Major Barry Riley graduated from the 259th Session of the prestigious Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Academy at Quantico, Virginia on Friday March 20, 2015. This academy class included law enforcement executives from 49 states, the District of Columbia, 24 foreign countries, 6 military organizations and 5 federal civilian organizations.

Internationally recognized for its academic excellence, the National Academy conducts 10 weeks of advanced investigative, management and fitness training. Attendance is by invitation only and attendees must have a proven track record of leadership and professionalism at their respective agencies. The 259th Session averaged 19 years of law enforcement experience. Most graduates return to their agencies to serve in executive-level positions.

Major Riley has been with the Warren County Sheriff's Office since 1996. He is presently the commander of the Jail Division. He will become Chief Deputy in September.
