Armed Suspect Robs Chase Bank in Deerfield Township

October 16, 2015 5:50 p.m.

On Friday, October 16, 2015, at 3:30 P.M., Deputies from the Deerfield Township Post of the Warren County Sheriff's Office responded to the Chase Bank, located at 3965 West U.S. 22, in Deefield Township, for a report of a bank robbery.

According to bank employees and witnesses, a black male entered the bank wearing a dark hoodie and a gladiator style Halloween mask. He displayed a weapon he was carrying in a blue or purple backpack and demanded money from a teller. After getting some cash, he fled across West U.S. 22, where he got into an older, silver Lexus and drove away.

The suspect, seen in the photo below, is described as a tall, thin black male in his 20s.
