January 25, 2016

On Monday, January 25, 2016, at 3:34 P.M., Deputies from the Warren County Sheriff's Office responded to Carter Drive in Wayne Township for a critical missing adult. The missing adult, Doyle L. Reed, 85 years of age, is reported to have the onset of dementia and other medical issues.

Mr. Reed left his residence on the morning of January 25, 2016, driving a tan 1995 GMC Safari Van with Ohio registration AP50RX. There is a Kentucky Wildcat sticker in the rear window and damage to the left rear of the vehicle His last known location was at the Centerville License Bureau, Centerville, Ohio. Mr. Reed left approximately 9:15 A.M and has not been seen since.

Deputies checked the residence and there is no indication of foul play. Mr. Reed and his vehicle were both entered into LEADS, a national law enforcement database.
