The Warren County Sheriff's Office is warning citizens about the possibility of an AK 47 style assault rifle being discarded in the area of Landen. During the recent incident involving the attempted murder of a Warren County Deputy Sheriff in the Landen area, the suspect discarded the weapon he used committing his crimes. It is unknown if this rifle is still loaded with ammunition. The sheriff's office is asking the public to be aware of this and keep their eyes open for any suspicious items. The rifle could be concealed in a piece of clothing or just tossed in a flower bed or wooded area. We are asking residents to check around their residences and unlocked sheds to see if the suspect discarded the item there. If anyone locates the rifle please contact our agency immediately.
