Detectives make arrest in Deerfield Township Robbery

July 15, 2016 1:00 P.M.

On July 14, 2016, detectives from the Deerfield Township Post of the Warren County Sheriff's Office made an arrest for the robbery of the Verizon Wireless store located at 8465 Mason Montgomery Road.

The robbery took place on July 3, 2016, where two suspects entered the store displaying a handgun and assaulted the clerk, before escaping with cash and several cellphones. With the assistance of detectives from the Germantown Police Department, who were investigating a similar robbery from their Verizon store that occurred on June 24, 2016, the detectives were able to identify one of the suspects.

The suspect, James D. Shell, 29, of Germantown, was taken into custody and transported to the Warren County Jail. He has been charged with one count of Aggravated Robbery and is being held without bond until his arraignment in Mason Municipal Court.

The other suspect from the robbery is still at large, and anyone with information about his identity or whereabouts is urged to contact the Warren County Sheriff's Office.
