Deerfield Township Man Indicted for Sex Crimes Against Children

July 25, 2016 11:00 a.m.

On Friday, July 15, 2016, deputies from the Deerfield Township Post of the Warren County Sheriff's Office responded to an address in the Stone Bridge Apartment Complex for a report of a man attempting to have sexual contact with several children. On the following day, deputies received another call about the same man, this time alleging some form of sexual contact had occurred, and the suspect was taken into custody.

After interviewing some of the victims involved, detectives presented the case to the Warren County Grand Jury, and they indicted the suspect on the following twenty-four charges:

- 10 Felony Counts of Gross Sexual Imposition
- 4 Felony Counts of Attempted Gross Sexual Imposition
- 3 Felony Counts of Importuning
- 1 Misdemeanor Count of Criminal Child Enticement
- 6 Misdemeanor Counts of Public Indecency

The suspect, Parposh Kumar, 65, of India, was staying with relatives at the apartment complex when the incidents occurred. He is currently being held in the Warren County Jail.
