### Detectives Investigating Found Human Remains

On Saturday November 3, 2018, deputies were called to South Clarksville Rd. near the Clinton County line, in Washington Township, in reference to human remains found by hunters. The remains were located in a wooded area along a farm field near US RT 22/3. Detectives with the Warren County Sheriff's Office were able to identify the remains as Jerold Haas, from Columbus, Ohio. Mr. Haas was entered as a missing person in September of this year by the Columbus Police Department. Mr. Haas was last seen at the BP Gas Station located at St Rt 73 and I-71 in Clinton County, on August 31, 2018. Mr. Haas was last seen wearing all dark clothing and carrying a black back pack.

The Warren County Sheriff's Office is asking for the public's assistance for any information in this case. We are asking anyone who possibly had seen Mr. Haas or noticed anything suspicious in the area at the time of his disappearance, to please contact the Warren County Sheriff's Office.
