CAPTURED Escapee from Community Corrections Center

Logan Michael Lee Fithen, one of two inmates which escaped from the <u>Community</u> <u>Correctional Center</u>, administered by the <u>Talbert House</u>^{*}, was apprehended today at approximately 3:30 p.m. near Senate Drive and State Route 63 in the City of Monroe.

After receiving a tip of a suspicious person in the area, personnel from the City of Monroe Police Department, The City of Mason Police Department, The Ohio State Highway Patrol and the Warren County Sheriff's Office surrounded the area. After tracking the suspect for approximately one hour, he was apprehended.

He is now currently held in the <u>Warren County Jail</u> on a charge of Escape.
