On Thursday, February 23, 2023 deputies took a report for two runaway juveniles from the Kings School District after failing to return home after school. These juveniles have been identified as 16 year old **Ella Janelle Cecrle** and 16 year old **Logan Scott Dunn**.

Logan is prescribed medications, which he does not have with him. Failing to take these medications as prescribed might cause him to be apprehensive with unknown persons. Ella is prescribed anxiety medications and may not be taking them as prescribed. If you observe these runaway juveniles, please reach out to law enforcement by calling 911.

Ella and Logan are confirmed to be traveling together. Their destination is currently unknown, but they have taken measures to alter their identities and falsely identify themselves. They were last seen leaving the area of the South Lebanon Target, and had dyed their hair color black. They are possibly traveling by Uber, Greyhound, or railway.
